40.00 Set Temp. quarter section post.

80.00 Intersect Town. line 29 lks. North of corner to Sec. 25. & 36

N. 89°06' W. on true line between Secs. 25 & 36.

40.00 Set charred stake with mound, trench and pits as per insts. for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corner.

80.00 Corner to Secs. 25 & 26, 35 & 36.
