Found cor. Sec. 16, 17, 20 and 21. mound & pits plowed over & destroyed. The stake 3 ft. long by 3 ins. square was found lying on plowed ground marked S 16 T 3, N on N.E. S 21, R 35, E. on S E. S 20 on S W. & S 17 on N.W. faces, with 4 notches on E. & 3 on S. edges.
