Chains 69.50	Ravine, course S.10° W.; ascend.
80.22	A point 700 ft. below the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor. and the Cor. of Secs. 22, 23, 26 & 27. Land; mountainous. Soil; stony, 3rd & 4th rates. Timber; pine, fir and tamarack. Undergrowth; pine, fir, tamarack, laurel, cascara, fern, huckleberry, alder, willow, pinegrass, rosebriar and bunchgrass. Good pasture land. Mountainous land, 80.22 chs.
	N. 0° 1' W., between Secs. 22 & 23. Gradually ascending over stony, grassy ridge, through scattering timber and undergrowth.
3.50	Descend steep hill through timber and undergrowth; bears N. 80° E. and S. 80° W.
9.80	Dry bed of stream, 3 lks. wide, in ravine, course S. 80° W. ascend steep, grassy hill through widely scattering timber; bears N. 70° W. and S. 70° E.
18.00	Top of rock-point-S.W.; descend.
20.25	Foot; ascend from head of ravine-S.W.
28.75	Summit of divide between Buck Creek and N. Fork of Uma- ritilla river; trail from tohler road along ridge. bears S. 65° E. and S. 65° W.; descend steep mountain through timber and dense undergrowth; thickets and fallen poles; hill bears N. 75° E. and S. 75° W.
36.75	Ravine, course N.W.; thence steep slope W.
40.00	A point 200 ft. above the Sec. Cor. and A pine, 5 ins. diam., born $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., I mark $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on W. side, from which, A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 69 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. 23, B.T. A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° W., 12 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. 22, B.T.
42.00	Open timber and scattering undergrowth on point-N.W.
