40.01		A point, 400 ft. above Sec. Cor. and Set an ironstone, 24 x 20 x 10 ins., 18 ins. in mound of stone on rock bed, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face; from which A fir, 30 ins. diam., brs. S.35°W., 20 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 25 B T. A fir, 10 ins. diam., brs.
