

56 Surveyed for Wm. Gardner Oct. 13 1888

For the Subdivision of Sec. 27  
and the Re-establishment of  
the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec corner between Sec  
27 and 34 and 26 and 27 and  
the corners to Sec 26 = 27 = 34835

I Commenced at the corner  
to Sec 25 = 26 = 35836 Hence West  
var  $20^{\circ} 15'$  East at 8070 chains Set Stake  
for temporary course to Sec 26 = 27 = 34835  
in East side of James Hutchinson's Hay corral  
offset North 50 links to get passed Hay  
Stack 100 chains Let back South on  
line on west side of Hay Stack

Hence West var  $20^{\circ} E$  3995 chains Set temporary Stake for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec corne  
8013 chains West Boundary Sec 27 75 links North of corne  
to Sec 27 = 28 = 33834 from which I run East on true line  
having an excess of 18 links in the 2 miles or  $4\frac{1}{2}$  links to  
each  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile I therefore at 4000 chains set Post in Slough marked  
 $\frac{1}{4}$  S. for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec corne between Sec 27 & 34 and at 7999 chains  
brought me to the East side of Hutchinson's Hay Stack  
could not plant corner. and drove witness stakes  
2 East respectively 10 and 24 links East and 30 of 50 links  
North of true corne which is under the East side and  
28 links South of North End of Hay Stack Oct. 13, 1888

I started at right corne on boundary line between Sec 33 & 4 Hence East 1650 chains  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec  
34835 this corne to Sec 3 = 4 34835 Hence East 80 chains from no corne Hence East  
4042 chains the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec corne between Sec 28 & 35 - making an excess of 42 links in 2 miles U.S. Survey  
I started at N.E. corner Sec. 27 Hence South  $2^{\circ} 45' E$  at 4000  
chains Set Boundary Stake for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. corne 8084 chains come under Hay Stack  
4125 chains  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec corne between Sec 34 & 35 - making an excess of 125 links  
see U.S. Field Notes. Hence North 4041 chains corne to Sec 26 = 27 = 34835  
Hence North 4042 chains Lanted Stone and Stake for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec corne between Sec 26 & 27  
Hence West through Sec 27 40 chains Set Post for temporary corne Sec 27  
7860 chains the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec corne on west side Sec 27 I then started at by corne  
on south side Sec 27 Hence North through Sec 27 var  $22^{\circ} E$  4020 the center  
8240 chains North Boundary 90 links East of  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec corne on south side Sec 27  
Hence South 4270 chains Set Stone 14 x 18 x 20 inch to corne Sec 27

I Commenced at the corner  
to Sec 20 = 21 = 28 & 29 Hence West  
591 chains Land Boundary Line 347 links  
across 5962 $\frac{1}{2}$  chains Set Post to temporary  
 $\frac{1}{4}$  corne 7950 Set Stake to temporary  
Sec corner Hence West 40 chains  
Set Stake to temporary  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec corne  
8117 chains West Boundary Sec. 30  
making an excess 197 links over  
the U.S. Field Notes in the 2 miles  
I therefore run East on line between  
Sec 19 and 30 and at 3968 chains  
Set Stake 6 x 10 x 27 for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec corne  
between Sec 19 and 30 and at 8020

chains Set Stone 5 x 7 x 18 for corne to Sec 19 = 20 = 29 & 30  
2011 chains Set Stone marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  for  $\frac{1}{4}$  corne on south side of S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$   
Sec. 20 I then started at N.E. corner of Sec 30 Hence South  
40 chains Set temporary Stake for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec corne 8052 chains the  
corne to Sec 29 = 30 = 81832. from which I run North  
and at 4026 chains Set Stone marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec corne between  
Sec 29 & 30 Hence West through corne Sec 30 4055 chains to  
Sec 30 and at 8023 chains West Boundary Sec 30

I then started at S.E. corne Sec. 30 Hence West  
4000 chains Set temporary Stake for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec corne 7983  
Chains West Boundary at corne to Sec 30 = 81 = 25836  
making an excess of 83 links over U.S. Field Notes  
I therefore run East 3941 chains set Stake to initial  
Point 35 links West of a stone set by Moses Austin  
County Surveyor for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec corne between Sec 30 & 31

I then started at my initial point for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec corne on both  
sides Sec 30 and run North through center Sec 30 at  
4022 chains the center Sec 30 at 8040 chains  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec  
corner on north side Sec 30. from which I run  
South 4021 chains and set stone marked C.S. for

center Sec 30 in S. 18 & 39 E. corne.  
P.S. Before commencing this Survey I started at the S.W. corne  
Sec 30 and run North on 16 range line between T 18 Rang 38 & 39 to  
test the correctness of corners claimed by residence as original U.S.  
Survey corners and find them to correspond with all corners tested on this  
previously run between known corners i.e. 12 to 13 links excess on each  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile over  
U.S. Survey Field Notes
