


## RECORD OF SURVEY No. 389

Commencing at the corner to Sec 5-6-31 382 previously established by myself  
in June 1906

Then 9 m North for 586

- 452 a point 25 ft West of corner set by Mr. Winkles
- 74.80 a point 184 ft West of corner set by myself in 1906 for corner to 5-6-738
- 80.50 The corner claimed to be found by own witness for corner to 5-6-738  
Thus at right angle to the right from said line bet Nos 586 I run west and at
- 78.50 a point 455 ft North of corner claimed by Fred. Johnson dug up Old Stake  
at point - a Mr. Glen claims his Father settled by suppose to be in Old Stake  
35 N. 16 33 6 W.M All persons agreed it must be the original corner to 5-6-687
- I then at request of Mr. Johnson started at the corner on long line  
bet Nos 12 824 and run North and at 40.50 the corner to 13-24-18 515  
thus North bet Nos 13 515
- 51.65 The corner to 12-13-7 518 known to be the latter A.B. Mc Cune, no corresponds  
to No Field notes as in ravine N.C.
- Thus North bet Nos 7-12 Extended from South on old line of Fred. Johnson by point 250 ft from  
40.53 a point 805 ft West of  $\frac{1}{4}$  the one old stake set by myself in 1906 in old Ravine N.C.
- 60.53 a point 727 ft East of corner to 5-6-6 37 on long line as above.
- 80.00 corner set by myself in 1906 for corner to 5-6-6 17  
I took his note bet nos 1-96
- 62.25 a point 805 ft East of corner to 586 N Range 33 & 34 S were established in 1906  
East bet Nos 6-931 as per plan
- 39.74 a point 147 ft South of old to be corner bet Nos 6-81
