

## RECORD OF SURVEY No. 423

Survey for Mrs. Jane Nelson - Athena of Reservation Boundary.

Chains Links

Tp. 4N R 34E.

Starting at a point 55.50 ch. S. of Sec. Cor. North 12-24 Tp-4NR 34E. on the Tp. line in the reverse of the Wild Horse line as given by the notes. and find the error of closing on the S. sec. line to be 701ks. E. of a point 34.40 ch. E. of Sec. cor. West. and 1.05 ch. North. From this it will be seen that the point of the survey that was taken as the sec. corner was off N. of the true line.

Starting at a point on the S. Sec. line of Sec. 24-34.40 E of SW Cor. I ran

Area = 101.2 Acres. Railroad cuts out about 6 acres.

Area of road on E = strip 25.10 x .45 = 114 Acres.

Note - The original line was run in with a compass and I used a transit so there may be some error between the two lines as run. Mrs. Nelson didn't want to pay for having the lines checked to see if they were right so I let it go at that.
