Known as the Weston Mountain Market Road
Know All Men by These Presents, That Lucinda M. Hyatt, widow of James W. Hyatt, deceased, of the County of Umatilla in the State of Oregon, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of Twenty Five & no/100 Dollar paid me, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit:

A strip of land 60 feet wide, being 30 feet on each side of the center line of the survey as now surveyed; Beginning at a point 30 feet north and 20 feet east of the center of the SE 1/4 of Section 27, Twp 4N, Range 36, E.W.M., said point being station 108/64 on a 4 degree curve left on said survey; thence around said curve for a distance of 206.1 feet; thence along a tangent with approximate bearing of North 71 degree 04' East for a distance of 654.2 feet; thence around a 3 degree curve right for a distance of 587.7 feet to a point in old County right of way, which point is approximately 1665 feet north and 40 feet west of the SW corner of the SW 1/4 of section 26, Twp 4N, Range 36, E.W.M.

To have and to hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
