Field Notes of Proposed Road

of Public Basement petitioned for by Anti Hanula

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Pendleton, Oregon, NOV. 28th 1899.

By Order of the County Court for Umatilla County Oregon at the regular Term for Nov. 1899 and dated Nov. 10th 1899 I met J. A. Christopher E. F. Meiners and John W. Stadermann Viewers on the 27th day of Nov. 1899 at the commencement of the proposed road of Anti Hanula who were duly sworn and subscribed to the necessary oath before me, after which we proceeded to lay out said road, commencing at the N.E. cor. of the SW 1/4 sec 15 in T 4 N R 31 E W M at stake marked R. three running East 9.95 chains three N 27° 30' E 9.60 chains. Total 19.55 chains to the public highway running NW and SE through NE 1/4 sec 15 T 4 N R 31 E W M set stake marked R.T. at intersection of said public highway.
